

COOPER ROWING CLUB  
BOARD MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, MAY 6, 2024

1. The meeting was called to order by president Janet Margusity at 6:15 PM by Zoom. All board members were present.
2. Treasurer's Report: Presently, \$36,631.74 in our account. We do not expect to receive money from the regattas until they are over.
3. Membership Report: There are five new members this month. There are a total of 31 people signed up for Learn to Row.
4. Learn to Row Report: The first group of four started class May 6. There is one spot available for July weekend, one spot for August weekend, one spot for September weekend. The flip test is mandatory to join the club. Missed classes/cancellations will not be made up. Once the classes have begun, a person dropping out will not be reimbursed. This can be reviewed on a case by case basis if injury or illness are involved.
5. Coaching Report: A letter was sent to each coach individually confirming dates, responsibilities and pay. Monday morning competitive sessions- going well with Tom W and Alycia coaching. Approximately 8-12 participants. Alycia will start Saturday mornings on June 1. Evening competitive sessions- consistently 4-5 quads. Evening skills- consistently 4 quads and occasional singles or doubles. Katie will join coaching in June.
6. Social Chairperson's Report: June 9, 2024 will be a fun scrimmage. Tom K will set up boats. A sign up sheet will go out toward the end of May.
7. Captain's Report: Cheeri-o continues to give track bites. It is 2004 boat and we will consider selling it. Supplies have been replenished. Oars will not be painted this season. We agreed to lend the George to a group to race in the Dad Vail. They are racing for Cancer. We asked the boathouse again to fix the goose lines and put strips on the oar racks.
8. Communications Report: Groupme App will go out to the membership shortly.
9. Regattas Update: Two regattas left to run. Sign ups are out. Siobhan will send out volunteer information to the Learn to Row people.
10. Old Business: Racing clothing is coming in a bit at a time. The casual clothing will be ordered soon.
11. New Business: Janet will talk to other boathouse presidents about the running of regattas next year.
